College History

4th of September in 1883 Ilia Tsinamdzgvrishvili founded Tsinamdzghvriantkari agricultural School in his own country, with the help of the public. He donated all his property to the school. Tsinamdzgvrishvili handed over 55 hectares of arable land and forest and 20 thousand liters capacity wine cellar. Tsinamdzgvrishvili request, the school took pupils regardless of rank, nationality or religion. School became compiled by statute of I.Gogebashvili and programs were being developed by Niko Tskhvedadze.

The special class was added in School in 1924 and it was renamed as **Agricultural School**. But from 1928 it was called **Tsinamdzghvriantkari Demonstration Agricultural Central School**. From 1933 the School was renamed as **Agricultural College**. From 1966 the school is called **Tsinamdzghvishvili Basic Agricultural College**.

In 1993 the College was transformed into **Tsinamdzghvishvili Humanitarian and Economic College**. In 2010, The College was liquidated. On 17 June 2014 **Ilia Tsinamdzgvrishvil Community College** was founded by the order of Minister of Education and Science.

Fruit Production (Stone crops/ Seed crops)

The aim of the program is to give a student Theoretical knowledge and formation practical skills.

Viticulture- Winery

The aim of the program: the aim of the program is to prepare highly qualified Winemaker, Who will perform the duties assigned to the quality, safety and labor standards. After graduating the student will be able to work in vineyard or Cellar, Afforestation and tending vineyards, grape harvest and processing, taking part in wine care of the technological processes. After the three-year program a Student will be equipped with a winegrower-winemaker and general / transferable knowledge and skills, learn about the field of values and ethical norms.

Career opportunities for graduates:

After completing the program, the person may be employed by a mid-level manager in viticulture farm, wine products, wine cellar, farm, counseling / information centers, companies consultant, also is able to manage his own family company to work with mid-level management at the level of any state and private companies, whose activities are viticulture and for winemaking.
