

## College History

On September 4, 1883 Tsinamzgvishvili their own country, at his own expense and with the help of the public to open Tsinamdzghvriantkari agricultural school, who donated all his property's life and. Tsinamzgvishvili handed over 55 hectares of arable land and forest and 20 thousand liters capacity wine cellar satsnekhita and pitchers, building classes and museums, houses for teachers, students' dormitory, two of his kitchen and dining room in the cellar, bakery and workshops. The university had its own manuals and machine-tools. Tsinamdzgvishvili request, the school took pupils regardless of rank, nationality or religion. School became compiled by statute of I.Gogebashvili and programs were being developed by Niko Tskhvedadze.

The special class was added in Scool in 1924 and it was renamed as Agriculatural Scool. But from 1928 it was called Tsinamdzghvriantkari Demonstration Agricultural Central Scool. From 1933 the Scool was renamed as Agriculatural College. From 1966 the scool is called Tsinamzghvishvili Basic Agricultural College.

In 1993 the College was transformed into Tsinamdzghvishvili Humanitarian and Economic College. In 2010, The College was liquidated. On 17 June 2014 Ilia Tsinamdzgvishvil Community College was founded by the order of Minister of Education and Science.
